1. A description of the final constructed project.
 - TLC Child & Family Services (TLC) contracted with Weeks Drilling and Pump Co. to install a new arsenic modular treatment system from AdEdge, in a pre-existing shed. The project included connecting the system to the existing well and related appurtenances to the new system. This project also involved trenching an area behind the shed and installing a backwash discharge line from the treatment system to an on-site orchard.
2. A description of the water quality of quantity problem the Project sought to address
 - Arsenic contamination in TLC's sole groundwater supply.
3. A discussion of the Project's likelihood of successfully addressing that water quality or problem in the future.
 - Preliminary test results have shown that the treatment system is working well and removing the arsenic from the water. We have confidence that the system will be able to address the water quality concerns at TLC now, and into the future.
