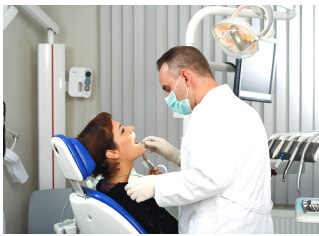


TLC'S SCCV LEGACY FUND 2020 ANNUAL REPORT

TLC is deeply honored that the Sonoma County Children's Village (SCCV) has entrusted us with its legacy gift of \$2.5 million. SCCV was a non-profit that used to run an innovative, nurturing group home for foster youth. After having to close its home, it supported foster youth through other programs, including funding orthodontic and dental treatments, summer camps and other enrichments, and made a substantial contribution towards supportive housing for homeless former foster youth at CSN. TLC feels privileged to be the new stewards of these funds and to continue the legacy of SCCV by providing innovative services to improve the lives of foster youth.

A Year in Review

TLC SCCV Legacy Fund & Orthodontic Program

2020 has been like no other, which has, understandably, included social worker focus on the global pandemic with limited attention to orthodontic care. This past year, there was a decrease in requests to the Legacy Fund, increased caregiver expectations, potential family exposure concerns, and a reduction of in-person visitation, which took priority. Despite these challenges, we were able to assist 10 youth with orthodontia services. As the vaccines arrive, we anticipate that this important need will resurface. We are ready and excited to meet this critical need.
