TLC made progress in 2021 filling the gap between the dental needs of foster youth and the lack of funding available through Medical by educating the foster community that such a dental/orthodontic program like this one exists.

2021 funding Increased by 20% over 2020 and 50% more youth were served.

The founder for the Sonoma County Children's village, Lia Rowley, an activist at heart, built her dream around a senseless murder that remains unsolved today. Lia's goal, to never have another Georgia Moses. Lia Rowley passed away in 2019 before having the opportunity to meet Georgia's sister Angel Turner.
