It continues to be a deep honor to be stewards of the Sonoma County Children's Village Legacy Fund. Orthodontic and dental care are urgent needs for foster youth in our community. Being able help youth access these services has such a direct, positive impact on their lives.

A Year in Review

TLC SCCV Legacy Fund & Orthodontic Program

Following a decrease in requests to the Legacy fund the previous year due to social worker focus on the global pandemic, increased caregiver expectations, potential family exposure concerns, and a reduction of in-person visitation taking priority, we greatly increased the number of youth served. In 2022, 33 youth were served vs 10 the previous year. The majority of youth reported struggles with self-esteem (including some purposefully hiding their smiles behind masks) due to their need for orthodontic care. These services helped bring their confidence back, which carries forward in all areas of their lives. Youth also received urgent dental care such as crowns and extractions, ensuring longevity of oral health.
