# HOW TO MAKE THE BEST SMOKEY CHIPOTLE BACON MAC AND CHEESE BY LL

1. BOIL PASTA IN A LARGE POT OF WATER. DRAIN AND SET ASIDE IN A LARGE MIXING BOWL. BUTTER OR GREASE A LARGE OVEN SAFE SKILLET (LIKE CAST IRON), OR 9X13" BAKING DISH. PREHEAT THE OVEN TO 375 F DEGREES.
2. IN A LARGE SAUCE PAN, ADD BUTTER AND MELT OVER MEDIUM HEAT. ONION AND COOK FOR 3-4 MINUTES UNTIL SOFT. ADD FLOUR AND STIR TO COMBINE. COOK FOR ABOUT A MINUTE
3. WHISK IN THE HALF AND HALF AND HEAVY CREAM, REMOVING ALL LUMPS FROM THE FLOUR. STIR IN SALT, PEPPER, SMOKED PAPRIKA AND MINCED CHIPOTLE PEPPERS. WHISK OFTEN, OVER MED HEAT, FOR 5-7 MINUTES, OR UNTIL THICKENED.
4. REMOVE PAN FROM HEAT AND STIR IN MOST OF YOUR CHEESES OF CHOICE HANDFUL AT A TIME. RESERVE ½ CUP OF THE CHEESE TO SPRINKLE ON TOP OF THE MAC AND CHEESE LATER
5. POOR CHEESE SAUCE OVER COOKED PASTA IN A MIXING BOWL. STIR TO COMBINE WELL, THEN TRANSFER TO A PREPARED SKILLET OR BAKING DISH. SPRINKLE WITH REMAINING SHREDDED CHEESE
6. COMBINE PANKO, ANCHO CHILLI PEPPER, AND OLIVE OIL. SPRINKLE OVER THE TOP OF THE MAC AND CHEESE, THE TOP WITH COOKED BACON PIECES
7. BAKE FOR 15-20 MINUTES UNTIL HOT AND BUBBLY AND THE PANKO IS GOLDEN BROWN. FOR A CRISPIER TOPPING, BROIL FOR A MINUTE OR TWO AFTER BAKING.

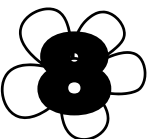

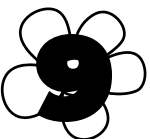

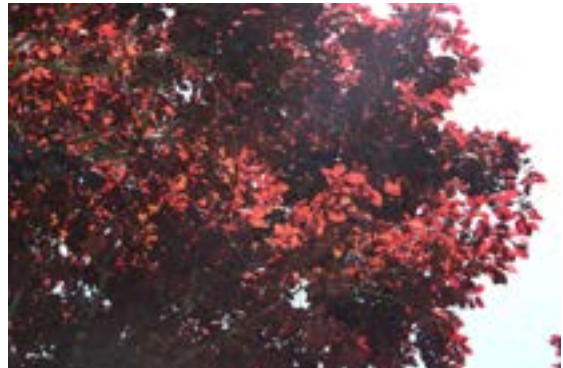
